



# Partnering with Ingleside



**Project YaREN is a proposed low carbon ammonia production and export facility in Ingleside, Texas, being developed by joint partners Enbridge and Yara.**

This project will prioritize employee and community safety, invest in the local economy and create a significant number of jobs in the Ingleside area.

## **Our community approach**

We strive to understand the social, economic and cultural characteristics of the communities where we operate. Over the years, we have learned a lot from engaging with and listening to our neighbors. Our long-term success depends on this connection.

We understand community trust is critical to successful and safe construction and operation. We respect the communities where we live and operate and believe they should benefit from our presence. We work diligently with

local stakeholders to communicate the safety measures in place at our operations that will ensure the well-being of their families.

Through this process of engagement, we also invest in community projects and initiatives that enrich communities, such as those that build potential in youth, celebrate community and honor Indigenous peoples and cultures by working with community groups as we develop these initiatives and engage with the public.

## How does this project benefit my community?

This facility will bring:

### 1. Well-paying, local jobs

We employ people in communities like yours – as of 2022, the Project YaREN partners had nearly 1,600 employees and contractors in Texas. Much of the \$161 million in salary earned by these people is put back into your local economies. This project will generate up to **4,000 jobs at the peak of construction** and **up to 200 permanent jobs once operational**, with \$15 to \$20 million in annual wages once the facility is operational.

### 2. Ongoing tax revenue

Every year, we pay property tax on our facilities, sales-and-use tax, corporate income tax, payroll tax and fuel tax. This is a source of revenue for local communities to use for improving and funding schools, hospitals, roads, or parks to strengthen their communities.

We are currently estimating \$20 to \$25 million in total tax revenue for the City of Ingleside over the three-year construction phase and more than \$400 million over 30 years of operation.

### 3. Operational spending

When we own assets, we also buy and lease supplies, equipment and services to operate and maintain these facilities. In Texas last year, we spent \$975 million on capital, operating and administrative expenses.

### 4. Community donations and volunteering

Every year, we support thousands of organizations in areas where we operate whose initiatives align with our three focus areas: **sustainable, vibrant and safe communities**. Our employees are also enthusiastic volunteers in the communities where they live and work.

**In 2023, we supported local Ingleside community organizations and programs such as Coastal Bend Bays & Estuaries, Communities in Schools Coastal Bend and park rehabilitation with the City of Ingleside.** We also invested in **safe community grants**, supporting first responder organizations in the greater Ingleside area. These donations are earmarked for safety equipment, training or safety education programming that keep communities safe.
